Tasting Notes

Vineyard: single estate

Tasting Note: Vivid dark red color, with a touch of youthful purple. Aromatics of Bing cherries and darker fruits. Luscious and full in the mouth, with a hint of cocoa and spicy licorice, ending with fine, lingering tannins. A real beauty.

Oak treatment: 12 months in seasoned French oak barrels.
